- ❖ The programme will enable you learn from a **broad base of fashion and textile techniques** in a range of media and materials. It will facilitate your progress to a career in the fashion and textile through successful articulation onto a diverse range of H.E. Degree programmes

### PATHWAYS:

#### HNC

- ❖ The Pearson BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) is at level 4 (the same as the first year of a UK honours degree).

#### HND

- ❖ The Pearson BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) is at level 4 and level 5 (the same as the first two years of a UK honours degree).

### FEATURES:

- ❖ This programme is designed to be a **two year HND level 5 course** which is equivalent to the first two years of a Degree Programme.
- ❖ On completion of the first year (at HNC level 4) accreditation can be claimed.
- ❖ **No formal examination.** Course work is mainly project-based and learners are encouraged to experiment with a wide variety of materials and techniques.
- ❖ **Studying in our specially equipped fashion and textile classrooms**, you will work on projects from the initial planning and research stages, through design and development, to the production of final outcome.
- ❖ **Top-up your HND in fashion and textile** to full Honours degree by spending just one more year.
